rause also she hath her Name according to that she is herself.

7. Wherefore it is much better for the People of the same Lande; the whiles they dwell therein, and haue no Desyre to depart out of it, through the Feare of God; that men giue them, in their Blindnes and ignorant Errour, to vnderstande of the Obedience which they owe to God and his Word, and to requyre the same of them; then that men shoulde open the Eyes of such disobedient knowledg vnto them, in their disobedience; and so then; if they indeuour them not to Obedience, to let them go on still with their Blindnes, till such tyme as they vnderstande that they are blinde, and be leadd by the Blindones; and that they then likewyse, growe desperat after some better thing, and woulde very gladly or goodwillingly be taught to the Lande of Peace and to his peaceable People, and be leadd into the same.

8. Verely, that the same Counsaile, is the best Counsaile to be vsed among the blinde People that knowe not their Errour, I haue sufficiently proued by Experience, among those that are ignorant of their Errour, and among the Despisers from vs and our godly Doctrine. Let eueryone therfore take diligent heede, that he tye or bynde not himself to fast vnto his Errour, with his knowing Wisdom, nor yet boist him of his knowledg; but let him studie or indeuour himself to enter into the vpright christian Life; and to the true vnderstanding of god, throug

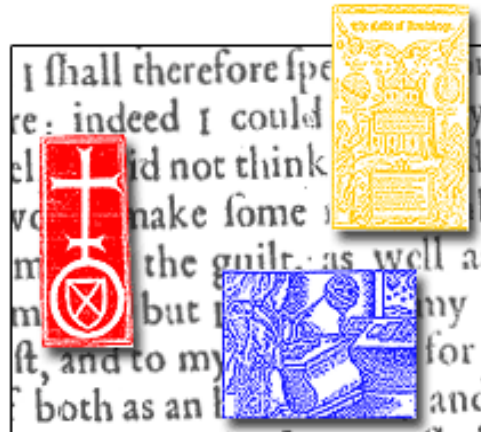
